Tops

Shirts/Blouses

- Solid colors
- Straight, button-down collar, turtleneck or mock turtleneck
- Long or short sleeves
- Polo-style (logo size may not exceed 1 ½")
- No T-shirts

Sweaters /Sweater Vests / Sweatshirts / Jackets

- Solid colors
- Must be worn over an approved shirt
- V-neck
- Crew neck
- Cardigan
- Logo size may not exceed 1 ½"
- No Hooded clothing



Hooded clothing may not be worn in the building.



Bottoms

Pants/Shorts/Skirts/Capri Pants/Jumpers

- Solid colors: khaki, black or navy blue
- No denim, blue jeans or yoga pants allowed.
- Pleated or flat-front
- Fastened at the waist
- Must be worn/set above the hip
- “Walking”-length shorts limited to 2” (inches) above the knee
- Solid navy blue or black shorts may be worn under skirts, provided they do not show

Leggings and tights may only be worn under skirts or shorts of an appropriate length. Leggings are not pants.



Shoes and Accessories

Belts (required for Grades 3-8)

- No logos
- Any color
- Made of fabric or leather
- Required for all pants/shorts made with belt loops (elasticized waistbands without loops are excluded)

Shoes

- Any color acceptable
- Closed toes
- Closed heel or strap heel



The following items have no restrictions, but individual cases may be subject to scrutiny for safety and security purposes: tights, leggings, socks, boots.



DRESS UP DAYS

Students are allowed to dress up for special days of the year, such as spirit days and picture days. These days are limited, will be announced and the following guidelines apply.

- Skirts / Shorts must be no more than 2" (inches) above the knee and be worn at the hip.
- Shirts must have sleeves, must not show cleavage and may not be skin tight. Shirts must be long enough to tuck in.
- Pants must be worn at the hip. Athletic pants are not allowed.

The following restrictions apply to all dress up day attire:

- No spandex, or see through materials.
- Garments may not be skin tight.
- Athletic wear (sweat pants, basketball shorts, jerseys, etc.) is prohibited unless it is our team uniform, worn by a player on game day at the coach's direction.

Hoodies are prohibited every day, even during dress up days.

Exceptions

No student shall be considered non-compliant with the uniform dress policy in the following instances

- Wearing a button, armband or other accessory to exercise the right to freedom of expression as provided by law, unless the button, armband or other accessory signifies or is related to gangs, gang membership or gang activity; hate groups; lewd or profane expressions; etc. (The principal or a designee will make the official determination of the appropriateness of the item in question)
- Wearing the uniform of a nationally recognized youth organization, such as the Boy Scouts or the Girl Scouts, on regular meeting days
- Wearing the uniform of the JROTC or other school military programs on required uniform days
- Wearing uniform modifications specified in a waiver obtained from the district by a parent or guardian
- Wearing non-uniform apparel on campus outside of the normal school hours

Restricted Attire

The following garments and styles of dress are strictly forbidden at school, athletic events and other school sponsored activities during school hours:

- Hats, caps, hair scarves, bandanas, sweat bands, wave caps, do-rags, hoods (religious customs are permitted with administrative approval)
- Denim pants, skirts, shirts, shorts, capris, jumpers and jackets
- Oversized pants or shirts
- Overalls or coveralls
- Sweatpants / sweat suits, jogging pants/suits, warm-up pants/suits, athletic pants/shorts
- Knit, nylon, spandex, biking or gym shorts/pants / clothes
- Skintight dresses or tops
- Tank tops, tube tops, halter tops, mesh tops, midriff tops, spaghetti strap tops.
- Shirts with ruffles
- Shirts made out of shiny material
- T-Shirts or tall tees
- Sunglasses
- Pajama tops or bottoms
- Flip flops , slippers, sandals, bare feet, exposed toes
- Heelies, Wheelies (shoes with wheels)
- Clothing or accessories with lewd, vulgar, obscene or hate language, slogans or pictures.
- Clothing or accessories that promote the use of alcohol, tobacco or drugs.
- Sagging pants / pants worn below the hips

Restricted Attire *continued*

The following garments and styles of dress are strictly forbidden at school, athletic events and other school sponsored activities during school hours:

- Secret society, fraternity or sorority symbols and lettering.
- Hair rollers, combs, picks or cosmetology clamps.
- Visible underpants, thongs, bras, camisoles or other clothing considered by the principal to be undergarments.
- Clothing altered by cuts, slits or holes that in any way exposes the skin.
- Detachable metallic teeth (unless required by a dentist with written documentation)
- Grills or Fangs

Anything else the principal or designee deems inappropriate or disruptive to the educational environment will be prohibited.
